Legislators will return to the Statehouse this morning with a full week of committee and caucus meetings on the schedule. Now that filing dates for both houses have come and gone, committee chairs will decide which bills will have a chance to be debated via public hearing. Expect a number of bills to clear second reading this week and make their way onto the floor for a full house vote.

The Senate Family & Children Services committee will meet this morning at 10:00AM and House Judiciary follows at 10:30AM. Session for both chambers will start at 1:30 PM.
