

Daily Legislative Update

Wednesday, January 16, 2019

Today, Senate and House committees will be meeting all morning and afternoon with a minor adjustment to caucus schedules. Unlike most Wednesdays, both chambers will hold a brief session in which they will be hearing from Indiana Chief Justice Loretta H. Rush. The Statehouse was buzzing with energy well into the evening yesterday with Governor Eric Holcomb delivering his third State of the State address to the General Assembly. Highlighting Holcomb's address to all 150 elected officials was his plan to help Indiana schools pay off a teacher pension liability that they've been gradually paying down. The one-time payment is expected to save local schools roughly \$140 million over the next 2 years. This plan continues Governor Holcomb's pledge to bringing Hoosier teacher pay up to par with that of fellow Midwestern states. For an in depth look at last night's speech, follow the links below.
