

Daily Legislative Update

Wednesday, January 23, 2019

While the temperature outside continues to drop, things inside the Statehouse are beginning to heat up. Committees have now gotten through all preliminary business and are getting into the “meat and potatoes” of their work within the legislature. Bills are getting through to second and third readings which means, if passed, they will soon be sent across the hall to begin the process all over again. Legislators have about a month to get all bills amended and passed before the switch takes place in late February.

Another schedule full of committee meetings awaits the General Assembly today, with an emphasis on fiscal matters for the House of Representatives. Ways and Means Committee will gather twice today, first at 9:00AM and then again at 1:00PM. In their first session, committee members will hear from the State’s Auditor, Attorney General, and Supreme Court as they present their respective budget proposals. W&M will then hear public testimony on two bills and vote/amend two more during their afternoon meeting.
