Today legislators are wrapping up their work and will head home for the weekend after completing week three of the legislative session. Only thirteen remain! As we said yesterday, committees are continuing to meet to make sure as many bills as possible can be heard and debated. It's important to note that due to the large number of bills yet to receive hearings, committee Chairs are constantly adding and removing agenda items, so be sure to keep up with each chamber's schedules.

Both caucuses will hold an early session today, Senate at 9:00AM and the House an hour later. The Senate will then have its Appropriations, Commerce/Technology, and Local Government Committees meet upon adjournment.
