

## **Daily Legislative Update**

Friday, January 25, 2019

The General Assembly will not be meeting today on the heels of a busy Thursday at the Statehouse. Committee meetings went well into the afternoon and we saw a few bills of note clear their first hurdle. Senate Bill 516, which modernizes Indiana's agricultural statute and allows farmers to legally produce and sell hemp passed in Commerce & Technology Committee 8-3. Although the bill passed with a sizable majority, look for it to be a hotly debated issue once it makes its way onto the Senate floor.

Legislators will reconvene Monday with committees set to gather in the morning and session in the normal 1:30PM time slot.

Bill tracking reports will also be sent out today, so expect them later this afternoon. If there are any members who are currently not receiving this weekly information and would like to, please let us know and we will get them added.
