Legislators return to the Statehouse this morning and will have a full week of committee meetings on the schedule. We've seen the first wave of bills pass full house votes and make their way across the hall but expect even more to follow suit this week. The clock is ticking for bills yet to be scheduled for public hearings, so the more time that passes, the less chances those proposals have of becoming law.
