It was business as usual on Monday for the Indiana General Assembly, as legislators continued to send bills through second and third readings and onto their next legislative hurdle. As more bills make their way through the legislature, lawmakers will begin teaming up with someone from across the hall to serve as the proposal's "co-sponsor". These individuals will serve as the bill's guide as it navigates the second legislative body. Look for these relationships to play a significant role in whether or not a bill passes or is killed.

Committee meetings will begin this morning with Employment and Family Affairs for the House at 8:30AM and Corrections for the Senate at 9AM. Both houses will convene for session at 1:30PM.
