

Daily Legislative Update

Thursday, February 7, 2019

Hoosiers from every corner of the state descended upon Indianapolis on Wednesday for the much anticipated committee hearing on Senate Bill 552. The "kitchen sink" gaming proposal took up almost four hours of committee time, but when the dust settled was passed with a clean 10-0 vote. The bill will now be recommitted to the Senate Appropriations Committee where all fiscal components will be debated and amended before being sent to the floor for a full house vote.

Legislators will have a light schedule today, with a select few committees set to meet before both houses convene for session. House committees will begin with Elections, Local Govt. and Agriculture at 8:30AM and the Senate with Local Govt. and Appropriations at 9AM. The House will gather for an early session at 10AM, followed by the Senate in the 1:30PM time slot.
