

Daily Legislative Update

Friday, February 8, 2019

Legislators wrapped up an eventful week on Thursday with a light working schedule for both houses. The General Assembly now has less than 20 days to get all of their chamber's bills sent through third reading before this session's official "half time". Most committees will only meet 2-3 more times before deadlines, so expect less time spent on public testimony and more member dialogue and amending of bills.

Now that filing deadlines have passed, all bills for this session are available online and actively being monitored via your bill track lists. As we've mentioned, the closer we get to committee report deadlines the more fluid agendas will be so it's important to stay up to date with calendars from both houses. This week's updated bill track lists will be sent out this afternoon and as always, if there are any questions please let us know.
