

## **Daily Legislative Update**

Tuesday, February 12, 2019

The clock continues to wind down for Indiana legislators, with just four session days separating them from committee report deadlines. That day will serve as the last chance for bills to be amended and adopted in committees. If proposals are still waiting to be publicly heard, it's becoming less likely that they will be moving this session.

Work continues today and both houses will have a sizable lineup of bills that are scheduled for 3rd reading. In total, 51 bills could be voted out from each chamber's floor and sent onto their next legislative stop.

House committees will get started with Employment and Family Services at 8:30AM and the Senate with Homeland Security and Tax/Fiscal at 9AM. House and Senate members will convene for a 1:30PM session.
