

Daily Legislative Update

Thursday, February 14, 2019

Yesterday provided House and Senate members yet another opportunity to hear public testimony on a number of bills and send them onto their respective floors for further debate. When the dust settled, we saw over 40 bills amended and voted out of committees. Expect this to prolong session meetings both today and Monday, as each of these bills will be discussed in length by each chamber's membership.

A relatively condensed schedule awaits legislators today and we anticipate much of their time to be spent on preparing for budgetary negotiations next week. The House of Representatives will be presenting their finalized budget proposal on Tuesday, so stay tuned for that.

House Elections and Local Government committees will kick off today's meetings at 8:30AM followed by Senate Appropriations and Utilities at 9AM. Session for the House will begin at 10:00AM and the Senate at 1:30PM.
