Deadline week has finally arrived and legislators will likely see an uptick in their hours spent inside the Statehouse over the next few days. Any bills that hope to make it through must be voted out of committee in the House by tomorrow and the Senate by this Thursday. Be sure to stay up to date with all committee and floor schedules as they will be fluid throughout the next 4 days.

The Senate will get an early start today with Public Policy committee meeting at 8:00AM. It will serve as the highly anticipated hate crimes law's first public hearing this session. House members will follow with Education committee at 8:30AM. Both chambers will convene for session at 1:30PM.
