

## **Daily Legislative Update**

Thursday, February 21, 2019

The focus of the Statehouse moves across the hall today to the Senate, as the second committee report deadline has arrived. Any bill that is not voted out of scheduled committees by day's end has been killed, but does not mean the language itself has been defeated. After today, legislators and those in the hallway will look for bills to serve as vehicles that carry their language in the opposite house. This trend will continue throughout the second half of session, so expect a number of amendments moving forward.

House members will not hold any committee meetings today but will convene for a 10:00AM session before adjourning for the weekend. Action on the Senate side will begin early with the "kitchen sink" gaming bill receiving its hearing in the Appropriations committee at 8:30AM. This will give the Senate's budgetary committee the opportunity to debate the fiscal components of the proposal. Senators will gather for session in the 1:30PM time slot.
