

Daily Legislative Update

Monday, February 25, 2019

The Indiana General Assembly will once again descend upon the state's capital this morning as they finish out the first half of the 2019 legislative session. Lawmakers will only be inside the Statehouse Monday and Tuesday this week and will then break until the following Monday when the second half begins.

With committee report deadlines in the rear view for both chambers, the next two day's agendas will be "session only" and the last opportunity for bills to be amended and adopted before being sent to the opposite house. Combined, there are over 90 bills that are scheduled for 2nd and 3rd readings today, so expect session meetings to run well over their typical lengths.
