Monday, March 4, 2019

The General Assembly will return to the Statehouse this morning to kick off the second half of the 2019 legislative session. All bills that passed the first house will start the process all over again in the second house, beginning with first reading for both chambers this week. You will also see the first wave of bills receiving public hearings in their new committees, so be sure to stay up to date with all committee schedules provided below.

The budget has now been sent across the hall to the Senate and members are wasting no time as their Appropriations committee will begin the second half at 9AM today. The House will follow at 10:30AM with Judiciary. These will be the only two committees for either house convening today. Both houses will gather for session at 1:30PM.
