It is once again Committee Day at the Statehouse and legislators will be hearing public testimony on a number of bills throughout the day. In total, 8 committees are set to meet which is an indicator that the legislature is beginning to churn its wheels once again!

As proposals continue to be introduced in the new house, you'll notice that more legislators are adding their names to bills to serve as sponsors. Look for these individuals to play a key role in the success of each bill as it progresses through the second half. Sponsors will rely heavily on their relationships within the legislature to get their bills across the finish line.

The House Education committee will kick things off this morning at 8:30AM, followed by the chamber's Courts & Criminal code committee at 10:30AM. Members of the Senate Judiciary committee will convene at 9AM, followed by Education at 1:30PM. As is the case with most Wednesdays, neither house will meet for session today.
