Thursday, March 7, 2019

We have officially entered the third quarter of the 2019 legislative session and lawmakers are working to push all bills through first reading in the second house. Once proposals are assigned to committees, leadership from each chamber will decide what bills will receive hearings and ultimately enjoy the prospect of becoming law this session. To stay up to date with all committee agendas, be sure to follow each body's schedule below.

The lone House committee set to meet today is Local Government at 8:30AM, followed by the Senate Appropriations committee which will meet upon adjournment following the chamber's 9AM session. House members will then gather for a 10AM full body session.

Updated bill track lists will be sent out later this afternoon that will include each approved bill's most recent status in the second house. If there are any questions regarding individual bill's status, please feel free to reach out.
