

Daily Legislative Update

Monday, March 11, 2019

Legislators return to the Statehouse this morning and will begin another full week of committee and session meetings. It may seem hard to believe, but we are now just one month out from committee report deadlines (4/9 for House, 4/11 for Senate). This gives lawmakers roughly 20 more session days to sift through their house's lengthy list of proposals and send them through to be voted on. Expect these deadlines to dictate much of the work done by both houses as the last day for third reading is 4/15 for the House and 4/16 for the Senate.

The Senate will occupy much of the Statehouse's attention this morning as its Family & Child Services, Agriculture and Environmental Affairs committees will meet at 9AM and 10AM respectively. Over on the House, the Judiciary committee will be the sole body convening for the day and they will meet at 10AM. Both chambers will then gather for a 1:30PM session. The budget crafting Senate Appropriations committee will meet upon adjournment as it is expected that Senate Republicans will release their version of the biennial budget in the coming weeks.
