

Daily Legislative Update

Tuesday, March 12, 2019

It was a fairly quiet Monday at the Statehouse yesterday, but we did see our first few bills clear 3rd reading in the second house. Senate bills 22, 80, 208 and 231 were the first to drop in what is sure to be a large bucket of bills to make it through the second house over the next few weeks.

If both houses are in agreement with any changes, the aforementioned bills will be concurred on and sent to Governor Holcomb's desk to be signed and become law. However, if the House and Senate cannot agree, the bills will be assigned to a "conference committee". This is a collection of at least one Democrat and one Republican from both houses that are responsible for hashing out all concerns held by both chambers before sending the final product the floor for final vote. The bill would then be sent to the Governor's desk for signature.

Committees begin early today as the House Employment and Family/Human Affairs committees are set to meet at 8:30AM. The Senate Veteran Affairs and Corrections committees will follow at 9AM and 9:30AM respectively. The House and Senate will hold session at 1:30PM.
