Legislators return to the Statehouse this morning to close out Week 11 of the legislative session. With another week in the books, leadership from both houses will continue to work diligently to hear as many bills as possible as deadlines quickly approach. The closer we get to the finish line, the longer the days may get so expect a few session days to pour over into the evening hours these next few weeks.

Today's agenda will be fairly condensed as is the case with most Thursdays. The Senate will jump right into session this morning at 9AM. Upon adjournment, the chamber's Commerce/Technology, Local Government and Utilities committees will gather for public testimony on a list of bills. Across the hall, the House Elections committee will be the sole committee convening for the day and will do so at 8:30AM. Members will then meet for a 10AM session.
