The General Assembly returns to the Statehouse today with another full week of committee and session meetings on the schedule. Next week will serve as the Committee Report deadlines for both houses, so this week will be that last time for bills to be heard in committees. Expect a great deal of time spent in committees to be spent debating the various amendments brought forth by legislators in the eleventh hour. The Senate will kick things off this morning when their Environmental Affairs Committee meets at 9AM, followed immediately by the chamber's Elections Committee at 10AM. The House's Judiciary Committee will start the day off across the hall, meeting at 10:30AM. Both houses will meet for session at 1:30PM.
