Residents in Indiana can now say, “they bought alcohol on Sunday.” At 12 PM yesterday, alcohol was sold as “carryout” for the first time since prohibition. Senate Bill 1 was signed into law last Wednesday by Governor Holcomb and was effective immediately.....Cheers my fellow Hoosiers!
