

Daily Legislative Update

Tuesday, March 6, 2018

After today, we will be at the legislative stage, known as, Conference Committee. A bill that survives the hazards of both houses but is amended in the second chamber in a manner unacceptable to the house of origin must go to a Conference Committee consisting of two members appointed from each house. The committee members attempt to reach an agreement that will be acceptable to legislators in both chambers. All four members of the committee must sign the Conference Committee report, and it must be approved in both houses. Bills sometimes die because no such agreement can be reached.
