

## **Daily Legislative Update**

Friday, April 20, 2018

Both the House and Senate majority parties have now met and plan to announce tomorrow a procedure for handling the legislation for special session. According to Speaker Bosma, "the plan is a "little different" than has ever happened in the past, with the goal of transparency, so everyone has in their hands what we're going to be working on very early." Leadership is still confident legislators will only need one day of special session to conclude their work.

State lawmakers are targeting May 14 for the session to address only a few issues - federal tax conformity, a Muncie-Gary school takeover bill and a school safety measure. It is anticipated the bills will be released by April 30th for review. In addition, legislators may consider some technical corrections during the special session, to fix unintended flaws in legislation passed earlier this year.
